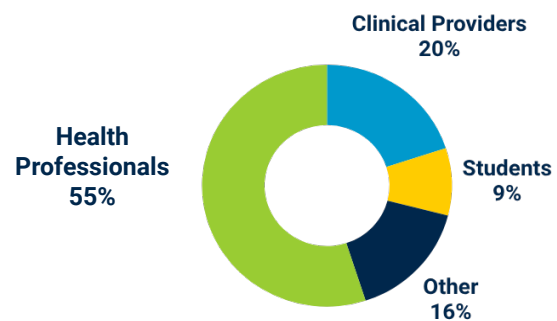
What is the Adolescent Health Initiative?

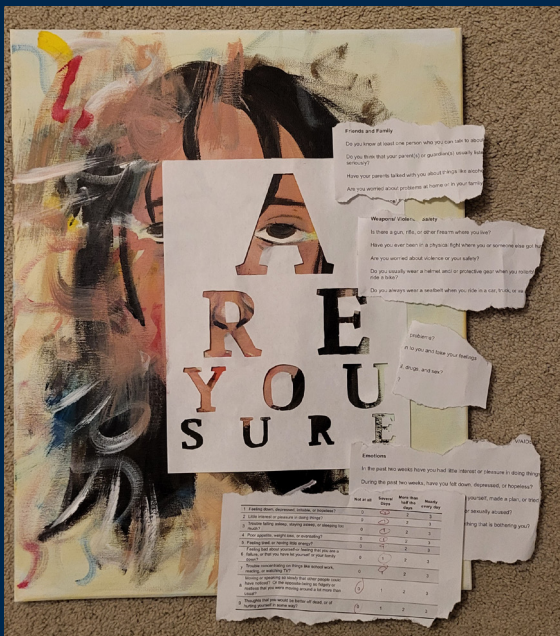

What is *AMPLIFY* ?

More than just an art exhibit, AMPLIFY guides young artists as they make art informed by their lived experiences of the health care system. Between paid honoraria and individual guidance, AMPLIFY will support 12 youth artists as they create art and learn their craft.

Finished pieces will be displayed for health care providers at the Conference Awards & Reception, allowing attendees to engage with the artists directly and learn from their experiences. Afterwards, the exhibition will live on in galleries across SE Michigan in 2027!
